**Susan says:** A locket is a great way to keep your grandmother close. A vintage piece which is delicately engraved would be ideal. Start by looking in antique shops or going to an antique fair. Or, you could wear a modern locket, maybe a heart-shaped or oval one. These are more readily available in jewellery sections of department stores or fashion jewellery shops. You could also wear a ring of your grandmother's or a pair of her earrings if they go with the rest of your jewellery.

Something with crystal will add glamour to your wedding look. If your vintage dress has some lace in it, then make sure that the earrings you find are really delicate so as not to overpower the delicacy of your outfit. Alternatively you may want to play on the vintage theme with a really beautiful brooch or hairpin that you could wear in your hair if you are having an updo, which again would add a delicate sparkle factor to your bridal look.
